#### WELCOME CENTER

- Provides an additional layer of protection to our campus
- Allows security to monitor and vet campus guests
- Equips security with a video monitoring station
- Affords entry by faculty, students, and parents through a monitored single point
- Enables campus guests to be checked in via the Raptor System and provides an identifying sticker
- Parents coming to campus will be directed to the west drive to park, and then to the Administrative Office to sign in and get a visitor sticker



Gates for carpool will be opened as follows:



### WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT FROM US

#### • Visible

- Security will patrol the campus
- Welcome and vet guests at the Welcome Center
- Stop vehicles attempting to enter campus without proper credentialing
- Monitor campus to ensure a safe environment
- Be present for all campus events

#### Proactive

- Address suspicious activity and/or persons
- Determine need for campus lockdown/evacuation
- Actively engage with First Responders

#### • Responsive

- Answer phone calls and texts from faculty and staff
- Immediately respond to any campus emergency
- Direct police and fire departments to campus locations as necessary



### OUR EXPECTATIONS OF YOU

- Review the Emergency Response Plan (one in every classroom)
- If you see something suspicious, notify the Safety & Security Team

- In case of emergency dial 9-1-1 first, and then call the Safety Phone
- · Keep all exterior building doors closed and locked
- · Lock your door when you leave your room or office
- Close the blinds in your room at the end of the day
- Close gates if you open them or see them open
- Schedule all campus events in Brightly and include security if after hours or on weekends
- Wear your school identification badge
- Notify the Welcome Center of deliveries via the spread sheet posted in the faculty portal
