

Carpool Information and FAQs (2025–2026)

Carpool Tags

- Each Grammar and Logic family will receive **4 carpool tags** — no registration required.
- Hang your tag on your **rearview mirror** when entering the **afternoon carpool line**.

Carpool Tag Pickup:

Tuesday, August 19 • 9:00 AM–12:00 PM during **Open Campus / Fall Frenzy**

- Unclaimed tags will be available at **Debbie Paul's desk** (Administration Office) after 12:00 PM on 8/19.
- **Tags are required** for afternoon carpool on the **first day of school**.
- **A new number is assigned each year** — please **discard all old tags**.

Multi-Family Tags

- If you're regularly picking up children from another family (e.g., neighborhood group, ballet, or sports):
 - A shared carpool number can be assigned.
 - Instructions and a sign-up link are included in the **Welcome Packet** and the **Covenant Copy**.

Carpool Changes

If your child is going home with another family: **Email must include:**

1. Full names of all children involved
 2. CC one parent from each family involved
 3. Indicate which carpool, Grammar 12:40, 2:50 or Logic
 4. **Example:** “Mary Jones will be going home with Lizzie Smith today (Tuesday) at 2:50 carpool”

Early Pickup Procedures

All early pickups require students to be signed out. Procedures vary by school:

Grammar School:


- Must be picked up **before 2:15 PM**
- Sign out at the **Administration Office**
- Email in advance:
 - Your child's teacher
 - Debbie Paul — dpaul@covenantdallas.com

Logic School:

- Students sign themselves out at the **Logic School front desk**
- Pickup at the **pavilion**
- Email Kristen Dow in advance: kdow@covenantdallas.com

If your Logic child is **going home sick**, they will sign out at Logic and be picked up from the **nurse's station**.

Phone & Parking Lot Policies

-  **No phone use while driving on campus.**
- Limited phone use allowed **only when parked** before carpool begins.

Grammar Walk-In (7:55–8:10 AM):

- Park in **Student Parking** on **Back Row**
- Exit campus by **8:10 AM** to allow Rhetoric students to park

Parking Rules

- No parking in **Faculty ("F") spaces** before 3:45 PM
- No parking in **Student ("S") spaces** after 8:10 AM
- Parents may use **Visitor parking** (west drive) or overflow parking at The Church in Dallas (13093 Meandering Way).
- Use crosswalks and model this habit for students
- **Campus speed limit: 10 MPH**



School Start and End Times / Carpool Procedures

Row 1: Lane closest to the pavilion.

Row 2: Middle row of parking lot.



Morning Carpool

- 7:30–8:00 AM — Logic School Drop-off, Row 2
- 7:30–8:10 AM — Grammar School Drop-off, Row 1 (If you have Grammar and Logic students, please use the Grammar line, Row 1)
 - Walk-in: 7:55–8:10 AM (If you choose to walk your student in, please park in Student Parking marked “S” on the *back row* and *use the crosswalks*. We ask that parents’ cars are off campus no later than 8:10 am to allow for Rhetoric students to park.)
- 8:15–8:30 AM — Rhetoric School Drop-off



Afternoon Carpool

- Stay in vehicles and follow carpool line
- 🗝️ **Gates open at 2:30 PM** for Grammar carpool

? Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Q: What if I'm picking up both a Grammar and Logic student?

A: Go through the **Logic School carpool** at **3:15 PM**.

Q: When can I get in line for Logic carpool?

A: No earlier than **3:10 PM**.

Q: Why is there a dot on my carpool tag?

A: It shows your family includes a **Logic School student**.

Q: Latest time to pick up my child?

- **Grammar-only:** by **3:10 PM**
- **Grammar + Logic (no extracurriculars):** by **3:30 PM**

Q: How does Rhetoric carpool work?

A: Rhetoric students **dismiss independently**; no tags required.

Q: What if a Rhetoric student drives younger siblings?

A: They must go to **Wileman Pavilion** by **3:30 PM**. Grammar and Logic students are released only to designated drivers.
