ACADEMIC REGALIA

The symbolism of academic regalia dates back to twelfth-century Europe. Until early in the last century, the gowns were worn during classes from secondary school onward, as is still the tradition at Oxford University. Today the gowns are reserved for particular convocations and processions only. Hoods, draped over the shoulders and down the back, indicate the academic discipline, the degree-granting institution, and level of mastery an academican has attained. The mortarboard caps represent the practical wisdom and constructive applicability of the degreed achievement. The tassels represent the appropriate adornment of knowledge and understanding. They are fastened to the center of the caps and are worn in the left front quadrant until a degree is awarded and then they are shifted to the right front quadrant following commencement. The colored cords and medallions signify the wearers' membership in various honor societies.

*The tradition of each class bearing a shield began in May 2004 when the class of 2010 presented a custom-made shield as a gift to the Grammar School upon their rise from the Grammar School into the Logic School. This tradition has since moved to the eighth grade class as they matriculate to the Rhetoric School. These shields represent a legacy of love and encouragement for the lower grades to follow.
